Brian E. Sheehan, from Bird Island, Minnesota, USA, was elected to serve as international president of Lions Clubs International at the association's 104th International Convention, held in Montréal, Québec, Canada, from June 22 through June 28, 2022. He served as Chairperson for Lions Clubs International Foundation (LCIF) from July 11, 2023 through June 25, 2024.

Past International President Sheehan is the founder and CEO of Rural Computer Consultants, a software development company.

A member of the Bird Island Lions Club since 1991, he has held many offices within the association, including council chairperson, long range planning chairperson, membership chairperson, retention chairperson, women's initiative chairperson, MD convention chairperson, GMT Liaison and GLT area leader.
